



SAVARRO 2017 Hexham Vineyard SOUMAH *of* YARRA VALLEY

Our Savarro story opens in the Northern Italian region of Bolzano where the green-skinned, tight bunched grape was first recorded in the 10th century. Over the millennia it travelled to all corners of Europe taking on many names including Savagnin, Heida and Bon Blanc to name a few. Our Savarro is very comfortable on our cool climate site in the Yarra Valley showing healthy dark green leaves and gentle ripening until it is gently picked and cool tank fermented on lees to retain the fresh aromatics of the variety.

A pale straw colour with a citrus and floral bouquet. Orange blossom palate with mineral honeysuckle and lime flavours. A textured palate with chalky minerality supporting a soft line of acid and subliminal spice.
